Setting:

Students will present their research in a poster board format during the conference to delegates and judges. Poster boards will be set up at various locations on the Trade Show Floor and students are expected to answer questions from the judges and attendees.

Poster Size:

Students are limited to 8' wide x 4' high poster boards to display their research.

Categories & Eligibility:

There are two levels of competition:

- Undergraduate
- Graduate

The winners at each level will be awarded a prize of \$500.00. Winners will be invited to the CEBC Awards Reception and Dinner on Tuesday, November 23rd (with one guest).



Both ongoing and complete research is accepted and students within one year of graduation from a program are eligible to apply. Students who participate in the competition will receive complimentary conference registration on Wednesday, November 24th.
